How to properly measure your Königs riding boots:

Shoe size:

The Königs shoe size is normal, but the boots are slightly tapered. If you have a wide foot/ball you should choose half a size larger. The same applies if your shoe size is between two sizes. Round up to the next half size.

Calf:


It's best to measure the calf in the evening, because the legs are usually slightly swollen here. Please put on your usual riding clothes such as breeches and socks.

Wrap the measuring tape loosely but without gaps around the widest part of the calf. At Königs you subtract 1 cm from this measurement and then you have your right order size.




Height:

1. With your leg slightly bent, mark exactly the "kink" at the back of your knees.




2. Then measure while standing, with a straight leg and no shoes, from the floor to your mark.

At Königs you add 6 cm to this measurement and you have your height including 1 cm for putting on the boot. E.g. Measurement up to the marking = 46 cm + 6 cm, order height 52



Topline:

If the measurement of your Topline (i.e. where the boot ends) is more than 2-3 cm smaller than your calf measurement, it could be that your boot is sticking out at the top of the arch. This is not bad and does not affect riding, but it looks not nice. In this case, contact our support, we will be happy to help you and find a suitable solution.
